## 1 LYNNWOOD TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT 2 3 **RESOLUTION NO. 10** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE LYNNWOOD TRANSPORTATION 6 BENEFIT DISTRICT; RELATING TO THE DISTRICT'S 7 CHARTER; AMENDING SECTION 5.04 OF RESOLUTION 8 NO. 1 9 10 11 WHEREAS, on May 24, 2010 the Lynnwood City Council established the Lynnwood 12 Transportation Benefit District; and, 13 14 WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 1, the Board of the Lynnwood Transportation Benefit 15 District adopted a charter stating operating procedures for the District, providing for the indemnification of the District's officers, employees, and agents, and established the time and 16 place for regular meetings of the District's Board; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the charter states that the Lynnwood Transportation Benefit District is to 20 hold regular Board meetings on the third Wednesday of March and the third Wednesday of 21 October of each year; and 22 23 WHEREAS, from time to time, special Board meetings may be scheduled to facilitate 24 general Board business; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the charter is not clear as to how Board meetings are canceled or 27 scheduled; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the Board of the Lynnwood Transportation Benefit District now desires to revise the District's charter to provide clarity as to the authority of the Board President to 30 31 cancel or schedule meetings; NOW, THEREFORE, 32 33 THE **BOARD** OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON. TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS: 34 35 Section 5.04 of Resolution No. 1, adopting the Lynnwood Transportation Benefit District 36 37 Charter, is hereby amended as follows: 38 39 The President shall serve as the ceremonial head of the District and shall preside over 40 all Board meetings. The President has authority to cancel and schedule meetings. The President shall, subject to the control of the Board, exercise general supervision, direction, 41 and control of the business and affairs of the District. On matters decided by the District, 42 unless otherwise required under Interlocal Agreement or by this Charter, the signature of the 43

President alone is sufficient to bind the District.
