

City of Lynnwood Water System Plan Project Narrative:

The project consists of the City of Lynnwood's adoption and implementation of its updated Water System Plan, which outlines the long-term strategy for maintaining, improving, and expanding the municipal water system. The plan identifies system needs, regulatory requirements, and infrastructure upgrades necessary to ensure reliable water service over the next 10- and 20-year planning horizons. Implementation of the plan includes constructing and sequencing the recommended capital improvements, such as water main replacements, reservoir upgrades, pump station improvements, pressure zone modifications, and other system enhancements intended to address aging infrastructure, improve system capacity, and support projected growth within the service area. Adoption of the Water System Plan provides the framework for prioritizing and funding these improvements, coordinating with regional partners, and ensuring continued compliance with state and federal drinking water regulations. No construction occurs as part of the plan adoption itself; individual capital projects will undergo separate permitting and environmental review as required.
