

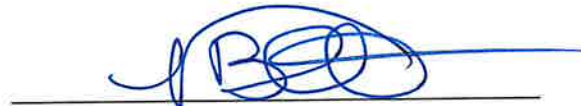

EMERGENCY COURT CLOSURE

Pursuant to General Rule 21, the Presiding Judge or, in the Presiding Judge's absence, any elected or appointed judicial officer of the court or, in the absence of an elected or appointed judicial officer of the court, the Director of Court Administration, may close the court if weather, technological failure, or other hazardous or emergency conditions or events are or become such that the safety and welfare of the employees are threatened or the court is unable to operate or demands immediate action to protect the court, its employees or property. It is the responsibility of the official ordering closure to notify the Administrative Office of the Courts of any decision to close a court both by electronic (telephone or e-mail) means and by forwarding a copy of the written order.
