- Nextdoor.com connect with your neighbors, share plants/seeds, resources and harvests
- Facebook Buy Nothing Groups: good way to get plants/seeds and cardboard (for sheet mulching) as well as to share your harvest with your neighbors!
- Seed swaps Keep an eye out for community seed swaps or organize your own!
