



Summer Garden Tips: Succession plant now for continued harvests  
**What to plant now: July-Aug**

From starts (choose fall harvest or overwintering varieties):

Brassica Family: Cabbage, broccoli, kale, cauliflower, collard greens, & brussels sprouts  
Alliums: bunching onions, overwintering onions, leeks, scallions (can also be direct seeded)

Direct Seed:

Carrots (work well to overwinter as well)  
Beets  
Parsnips  
Kale  
Turnips  
Mustard greens

In August you can resume seeding more cool-weather crops, like what can be planted in early spring including:

Spinach  
Lettuces  
Bok choy & similar  
Radishes  
Mache/corn salad

**Don't forget!**
