Every year oil and other automotive fluids find their way to Puget Sound and other waterways, hurting wildlife and habitat.

What are some healthy maintenance habits to follow?

- Stop drips. Check for oil leaks regularly and fix them promptly. Keep your car tuned to reduce oil use.
- Use ground cloths or drip pans beneath your vehicle
 if you have leaks or are doing engine work. Clean up
 spills immediately. Collect all used oil in containers
 with tight fitting lids. Do not mix different engine
 fluids.
- Never dispose of oil or other engine fluids down the storm drain, on the ground or into a ditch.
- · Recycle used motor oil.
- Buy recycled (re-refined) motor oil to use in your car.
