

City of Lynnwood, Amie Hanson, PO Box 5008 Lynnwood, WA 98046-5008, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit.

The proposed project, 2019 Overlay and Curb Ramp Project, is located at 68th Ave W from 196th St SW to 300 ft south of 202nd St SW, 188th St SW from SR99 to 48th Ave W, and 51st Pl W from 188th St SW to cul-de-sac in Snohomish county.

This project involves 2.5 acres of soil disturbance for Highway or Road construction activities.

The receiving waterbodies are Hall Creek, Scriber Creek.

Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this Application, or interested in Ecology's action on this Application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II anti-degradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
