The Americans with Disabilities Act Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan (SETP) will guide the City in evaluating the accessibility of facilities, programs and services and help guide the prioritization to update facilities, programs and services to be accessible and compliant to all applicable laws. This Plan is intended to be a living document that is regularly updated as programs and services change, as barriers are removed, and new facilities come under ownership or control of the City.

The SETP demonstrates the City of Lynnwood's commitment to providing equal access to our community, including public programs, services, facilities, and activities for community members with disabilities.

Thank you to all of the community members who provided input and shared their lived experiences as part of our Stakeholder Group during this project. Their input was critical in shaping the SETP Plan, prioritizing barrier removal, and making recommendations for continuing progress.
