SUBMITTAL OF SEALED BIDS:

Sealed bid proposals ("Bids") will be received by the Public Works Deputy Director, or the Public Works Deputy Director's representative, at Lynnwood City Hall, 19100 44th Avenue W., Lynnwood, Snohomish County, Washington, 98036 (or mailed to P.O. Box 5008, Lynnwood, WA 98046-5008), until 2:00 p.m., February 14, 2018, for the following project ("Project"):

Sewer Improvements Related to Lift Station # 4, # 8 and # 10, Project No. 2

Capitalized terms not defined in this Invitation for Bids shall have the meanings set forth in the Project Manual of which this Invitation for Bids is a part.

BID OPENING:

At the time and date above stated, the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud ("Bid Opening"). Bids are to be submitted only on the bid proposal forms provided with the Project Manual. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond, cashier's check, certified check, or postal money order in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid. Bids received after the time fixed for the Bid Opening will not be considered.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

The project will consist of the construction of a new 8-inch diameter sewer force main and new 12-inch diameter gravity sewer from Lift Station #4 along Alderwood Mall Boulevard and Alderwood Mall Parkway to Lift Station #8. Construction of a new 18-inch diameter gravity sewer along 40th Ave. W., the Interurban Trail and crossing 44th Ave W. to Lift Station #10. Work will also include trench restoration, bored casing pipe, asphalt pavement restoration, permanent pavement markings, and other work.

All Bids shall be based upon compliance with the Project Manual (including, without limitation, the Contract Plans and Specifications). The estimated cost range for this project is \$3,750,000 to \$4,250,000. The project shall be Physically Completed within 120 working days of the Notice to Proceed.
