
- APPLIES TO STREETSCAPE TYPE 3 CORE, AND TYPE 3 EXTENSION.
- SCHEMATIC LAYOUT TO SHOW HORIZONTAL RELATIONSHIPS AND CLEARANCES. FINAL LAYOUT TO BE APPROVED THROUGH CITY REVIEW.
- MINIMUM 50% OF BENCHES, BUT NO LESS THAN ONE, IN PUBLIC SPACES SHALL MEET ADA REQUIREMENTS.
- 3.1. ADA AND NON-ADA BENCHES SHALL BE WELL DISTRIBUTED.
- 3.2. FOR ALL ADA-COMPLIANT BENCHES, PROVIDE FULL BACK SUPPORT OR AFFIX TO WALL, EXCEPT AS ALLOWED BY THE CITY.
- 3.3. IF NO BACK SUPPORT IS PROVIDED, PROVIDE 5'-0" CLEAR SPACE AROUND ALL SIDES OF BENCH.
- 3.4. PROVIDE IDENTIFYING MARKER ON ADA-COMPLIANT BENCHES.
- 3.5. ADA COMPLIANT BENCH DIRECTION SHALL BE TOWARD VIEW CORRIDOR AND AS DIRECTED BY THE CITY.
