

- 1. $\,\,$ THIS STANDARD APPLIES TO ALL CUTS TO ARTERIAL STREETS AND ALL PAVEMENT LESS THAN 5 YEARS OLD.
- 2. FOR TEMPORARY PATCHING SEE STD. ST-TRE-7.
- OVERLAY AREA MAY BE MODIFIED BY CITY ON OLDER PAVEMENT DEPENDING ON CONDITIONS OR SCHEDULED CONSTRUCTION MAINTENANCE.
- ADJUST ALL UTILITY CASTING TO FINISH GRADE AND RESTORE CHANNELIZATION MARKINGS AND LOOP DETECTORS.
- RESTORATION OF PAVEMENT 5 YEARS OLD OR LESS SHALL BE THE FULL WIDTH OF THE ROADWAY (LANE EDGE TO LANE EDGE) FOR THE ENTIRE FRONTAGE OF THE PARCEL OR AS DIRECTED BY THE CITY.
- ROADWAY TRENCHING THAT ENCOUNTERS ROADWAY BEDDING LOGS WILL REQUIRE GEOTECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS PRIOR TO BACKFILL AND PATCHING.
- 7. IF THERE ARE MORE THAN 3 PARALLEL OR PERPENDICULAR PATCHES PROPOSED WITHIN 100 LINEAL FEET OF ROADWAY, THE DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO GRIND AND OVERLAY THE ENTIRE AREA TO PUBLIC WORKS STANDARDS.
