



Hydrant Permit Requirements and Fees

Requirements and details for obtaining water use permit:

- Possess current City of Lynnwood Business License and Washington State UBI Contractor number
- Provide adequate backflow protection at the hydrant; DCVA OR RPBA
- Submission of backflow assembly test report from connection to proposed hydrant
- Hydrant must be manned when in use and be available for use by the fire personnel
- Applicant will operate hydrant with proper hydrant wrench and be aware of proper valve operation.
- Damage deposit refunds must be requested in writing and are subject to any outstanding invoices at the time the permit expires. Any damage to the hydrant will be deducted from the deposit
- No metering is required
- One permit per meter per backflow assembly. Transfer of hydrant location or backflow assembly used must be approved by the City prior to changes

ALL HYDRANT PERMITS REQUIRE THE APPROPRIATE BACKFLOW ASSEMBLY BE INSTALLED AT THE HYDRANT AND THE BACKFLOW ASSEMBLY MUST HAVE BEEN TESTED WITHIN THE PAST YEAR WITH DOCUMENTATION SHOWING IT HAD PASSED. PUBLIC WORKS MUST APPROVE THE WATER USAGE AND TYPE OF BACKFLOW ASSEMBLY REQUIRED. TO AVOID WATER HAMMER, THE HYDRANT VALVE MUST BE OPERATED SLOWLY. A HYDRANT WRENCH MUST BE USED TO OPERATE THE HYDRANT. THE PERMIT HOLDER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY HYDRANT DAMAGE, ASSOCIATED FEES AND FOR THE COST OF REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF THE HYDRANT.

THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRICT THE USE OF WATER AT ANY TIME AND ANY VIOLATIONS OF THIS RESTRICTION WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$300.00 FINE FOR EACH VIOLATION AS PER RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD.

THERE SHALL BE LEVIED A CHARGE OF \$200.00 AGAINST EACH PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION WHO SHALL TAKE WATER FROM ANY WATER LINE, RESERVOIR, FIRE HYDRANT, STANDPIPE, BLOW-OFF PIPE OR ANY FACILITY OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD WITHOUT THE CITY'S CONSENT AND WITHOUT FIRST HAVING OBTAINED A PERMIT TO TAKE SUCH WATER; AN ADDITIONAL \$380.00 WILL BE ASSESSED FOR THE WATER USED. SUCH SUM SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE IMMEDIATELY UPON THE TAKING OF SUCH WATER. **NON-POTABLE USE ONLY.**
